

The WEO International School of EUS (WISE) founded in 2018, is a state-of-the-art EUS training program focused on teaching a specialized group of doctors in their early careers, under the guidance of course founder and director, Professor Dong-Wan Seo. WEO's aim is to groom the selected trainees and to provide the necessary tools to become future leaders in the area of EUS.

Building on the strength of WISE, and continuing to WISE program objectives, the first WISE Egyptian chapter was held in Egypt in 2022- 2023. This course was directed and guided by Professor Dong-Wan Seo; the WISE founder, and Professor Elsayed Ghoneem; Associate professor of Gastroenterology, Mansoura University as a hands-on training course on the diagnostic linear EUS from basic to more advanced level through a 3-module program.

As a commitment of WEO to broadening the scope of EUS education and training on a global scale. WEO is happy to announce that a similar course focusing on hands-on training, The WISE Egyptian Chapter 2024, will commence in May 2024. This course will focus on linear EUS and will be comprised of lectures, case presentations with discussion, and hands-on training.

This course is jointly organized by WEO and the EUS group of the Egyptian Society of Digestive Endoscopy (ESDE) with the participation of Five Egyptian tertiary Centers.

#### Program information

- The course consists of two modules.
- Each module will be Five days.
- Each day will begin with learning lectures and then Two sessions of hands-on training.
- In observation and hands-on training there will have 3 operating rooms.
- Four candidates in each room with rotation on the other room with each session.
- One international day lectures: Lectures by international experts
- Four trainers are responsible for every step of observation and Hands on training.
- The last module will be followed by graduation day, Ceremony.

## Requirements

- Only 12 candidates will be accepted for the course.
- Candidate should have EUS machine in his working unit.
- Acceptance and recommendation letter from the head of his unit.
- High level in EGD and Colonoscopy, Diagnostic and Therapeutic.
- Basic level or more in ERCP.
- Should have at least basic knowledge in EUS (Recommendation needed).
- Pass the pretest on basic EUS.
- In case of many candidates fulfill the criteria, they should have Personal interview.
- Open to trainees from Egypt and neighboring Arab countries.
- Must be WEO Individual Members. Therefore, please factor in enough time (7 working days) to apply for the WEO individual membership before applying for the WISE Egyptian Chapter
- Course fees will be at a subsidized rate of Euro 2000
- IMPORTANT: This is NOT an online training course. Physical participation is essential. Training will take place in Egypt.
